## **BODRUM**

Known in ancient times as Halicarnassus, Bodrum was the birth place of Herodotus and the site of King Mausolus's Tomb, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world.

Whitewashed and flower-decked, Bodrum is the Aegean Coast's most charming city and sophisticated resort. Anchored to the southern shore of the Bodrum Peninsula, it lies in a sunny region of spectacular scenery and sandy beaches. If you have booked a 'Blue Cruise' from overseas, your voyage may well begin in Bodrum. Or if you would like to start your own sailing holiday while in Turkey, this is a good place to do so. The crystal-clear waters of the Aegean make Bodrum a paradise for divers of all levels, especially beginners. Sailing is also one of the most popular activities in Bodrum for all ages and levels of experience.

One of the major attractions of Bodrum, next to its vivid night life which features everything a weary sailor might look forward to, is the Museum of Underwater Archaeology, ranked among the top 9 museums of Europe in 1995 and housing among other artifacts the full-scale reconstructed wreck of a 7th Century Eastern Roman ship.



### **THE MARINA**

Travelling yacht hoist with 70 tons lift capacity, drydock hardstanding for 25-40 yachts, provision store, waste oil and refuse disposal, fully-equipped fire-fighting team, winterising, hawser service, valeting, diver service, battery charging and monitoring.
