Welcome...

Dear Guests,

Kemer Turkiz Marina has been in operation for 22 years, and is licensed by the Ministry of Tourism. We offer excellent all year round berthing for 230 boats afloat and 140 on the hard. Antalya International Airport is just an hour's scenic ride away.

The marina meets international safety standards, including all kinds of repair facilities and a travel lift with a 60 tonne capacity. Because of the high quality of the facilities, Kemer Turkiz Marina has been awarded "Five Golden Anchors" by the Turkish Yacht Harbour Association.

Kemer Turkiz Marina is a Port of Entry providing all official offices within the marina. There is also a Coast Guard post with one of Turkey's most modern Coast Guard vessels available to provide additional emergency services to the yachts if needed. The marina offers ideal conditions for liveaboards with a full range of social, sporting and cultural activities during the winter months. Weekly classical music and ballet performances in Antalya are very popular. There is a club house and bar, a library with books in several languages, and a restaurant available for the use of the liveboard community. Combined with the best climate in all of Turkey with the protection of the high Taurus mountains, Kemer Turkiz Marina is one of the very best liveboard marinas in the entire Mediterranean.

The town of Kemer is a small beautiful holiday resort nestling below dramatic mountains where the different greens of pine forests and orange groves clothe the lower slopes in colourful contrast with the savage rock above, clad with winter snow on the highest peaks. Kemer was an isolated fishing village at the beginning of the 1980s but has now become one of the most important tourism centres in the Gulf of Antalya. Kemer and its immediate vicinity have a winter population of 55,000, which increases to 160,000 in summer. It is a very friendly town with a weekly vegetable market, and frequent buses to Antalya and the surrounding area. Kemer offers two private modern hospitals which are affiliated with new hospitals in Antalya, where there is also a fully equipped University Hospital.

Here too is one of the best locations for boat owners to discover the history of Turkey. You will walk in the ancient area of Lycia, famous for the bravery of its people who fought to the last person against the Persians. On a mountain top is Thermessos, the city that Alexander the Great could not conquer, and not far away is the sunken city of Simena. The Pamfilia region is also very close, offering visits to the Aspendos amphitheatre, Perge, and the ancient port of Side. Only a short car ride away lies Cappadocia, where the first Christian settlers hid themselves in huge underground cities, some of which are open to visitors. The marina is also an excellent gateway to visit the Eastern Mediterranean countries.

On the 1st of January 2007, Kemer Marina united with the Turkiz Hotel, a five star hotel with an outstanding Thalasso Centre. The Turkiz is on one side of the marina, and Moonlight Bay is on the other side with many exciting recreational facilities.

The Turkiz Hotel provides a private sandy beach which is located close to the marina. There are 164 rooms including superior double rooms, junior, senior, and presidential suites. Our unique Thalassotherapy Centre offers a variety of treatments. The hotel includes an A La Carte restaurant, "La Terrasse", with a magnificent view of the sea and the marina.

Nearby, Moonlight Bay is spread out over 55,000 square metres. This sandy beach also has a swimming pool with water slides, an amphitheatre, food court, shopping centre, dolphinarium with sea lion and dolphin shows, tennis courts, and a variety of water sports.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our beautiful part of the world.

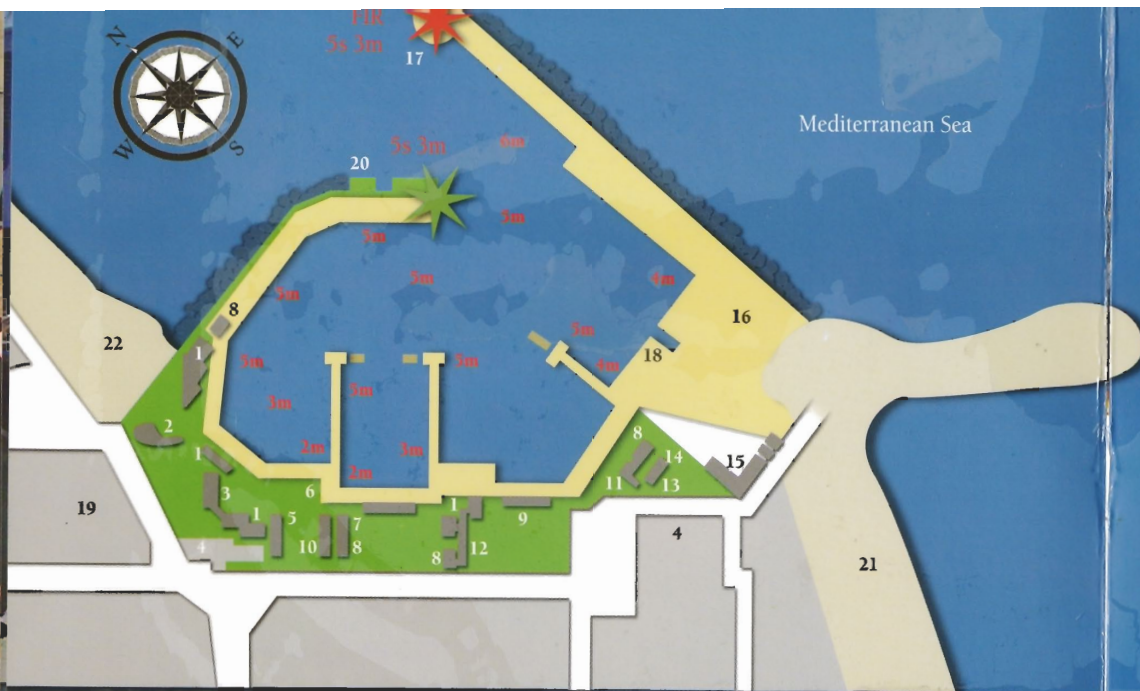

### Xanthos

The ancient Lycian capital of Xanthos was discovered in 1838, and is known to have been a free and independent town until it was captured by the Persians in 545BC.

### Kekova

One of the most scenic and sheltered anchorages in Turkey - don't miss the castle centrally sited at Kalekoy.

### Arycanda

This ancient town is located 26 km from Turuncova on the Finike-Elmalı highway. It probably existed in the 5th century BC though it was largely destroyed by an earthquake in 240 AD. It recovered enough to survive until the 11th century AD. There are many buildings in a good state of preservation.

### Myra

Situated between Finike and Kas, Myra is a 5th century BC settlement which became one of the most important of six major Lycian cities. It was abandoned in the 9th century AD after the Arab invasion, but the 8th century Church of St. Nicholas (Santa Claus), rock tombs, and the theatre have survived to make Myra worth visiting.

### Chimera

Between the magnificent anchorage at Cineviz and the ancient harbours at Phaselis, you may see the Chimera breathing fire on shore near the village of the same name if the night is dark enough. Reaching it by day makes a wonderful hike through delightful scenery. The flames are fuelled by methane burning for thousands of years through cracks in the rock. In ancient times, they were thought to come from a fearsome monster, part lion, part goat and part dragon.

### Phaselis

Don't miss this utterly charming little peninsula with three ancient harbours whose protecting moles are still providing shelter (and chartered obstructions) for visiting yachts. There is a delightful theatre, an aqueduct, a necropolis, the town's main street with sidewalks and shops, public baths, and the remains of a town gate in honour of the Emperor Hadrian. His empire stretched from well east of here to Scotland where he built a vast wall to keep marauders out of England. Phaselis is an easy day trip from Kemer by private vessel, gulet, or road.

### Lymyra

This town dates back to at least the 5th century BC. It suffered great damage from an earthquake in 141AD and later Arab invasions. Its ruins consist of an acropolis, the settlement itself, and a necropolis.

### Thermessos

This well-preserved city, 30 km north west of Antalya, was of great strategic importance. It is sited on a natural platform towering above the surrounding area, now a National Park.

### Perge

18 km east of Antalya lies Perge, inland and untouched by the ravages of pirates. A great many statues and other valuable items have been unearthed in archaeological digs.

### Side

Despite several earthquakes, Side has preserved the majority of its buildings, and is one of the best-known classical sites in Turkey. It is situated 65 km east of Antalya, and was the main seaport in this region, as well as a centre of culture and scholarship.

### Aspendos

This extensive site has many buildings and aqueducts in remarkable condition. Most famous is its theatre built in the second century A.D. to seat up to 17,000 people, and still in use today. Attending a summer concert or an opera there under a canopy of stars can be a magical experience.

## Kemer Yacht Club



Kemer Yacht Club is located at Kemer Turkiz Marina and supported by the marina management and Kemer Municipality at Antalya / Kemer since 1999.

Aims of this foundation are to introduce the younger generation with sailing - sea sport activities and provide basic education for sailing to the people in the Antalya Region. One of the missions is to develop an interest in sailing and cruising for the local people.

From the beginning the club has promoted sport and education activities, and helped established many new sailing clubs.

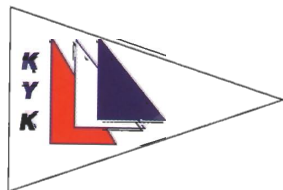
The club has organized summer and winter camps in which 350 young sailors have learned to sail optimists and lasers. Forty five of these sailors have been selected to represent our region in the national league.

Our fleet is continually growing. At present the club has 30 optimists, 4 lasers, 2 education boats and 1 adult sailing yacht for training. In the region it is the most successful team in the league.

With the basic and advance courses 183 sea lovers joined the sailing world. With these new members, the club has started the first sailing races in the region.

Outside of the region the club took a role as a founding member of the Amateur Sailing Federation of Turkey and is a member of the board of directors.

## Eastern Mediterranean Yacht Rally

The Eastern Mediterranean Yacht Rally is truly an international event. The main objectives of the Rally: to open all ports and harbours in the Eastern Mediterranean to yachtsmen, to encourage friendship and camaraderie among yachtsmen of many different nation, and to develop a greater fellowship with the various dignitaries and local populations that we visit.

EMYR is the largest yacht rally organized by amateur sailors.

Since 1990 yachtsmen from all over the world have converged on Turkey to participate in the Eastern Mediterranean Yacht Rally. Beginning with a small fleet of 17 yachts in 1990 it expanded to fleet of 120 yachts from 17 different nationalities in 1999.

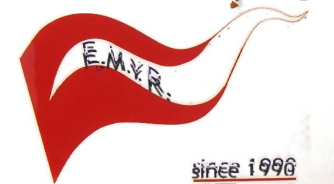
